MELISSA

MELISSA (CONT'D)

Hey kids, do you want to know what I like to do when I ride a train and look for Honey?

KIDS

No, what?

MELISSA

I like to sing a song. Did everyone bring an instrument?

All the kids bring out pots, pans, spoons or anything that makes sound.

Melissa sings the On the Train Looking For Honey Song.

INSERT SONG LATER

MELISSA (CONT'D)
